Maplewood Academy in Hutchinson, Minnesota is owned and operated by the Minnesota Conference. It was founded in 1904 in Maple Plain, Minnesota. Its predecessors were the Minnesota Conference School established in Minneapolis in 1888 by Charles C. Lewis and the Minnesota Industrial School in Anoka, Minnesota. In 1928 it was voted to combine the Hutchinson Theological Seminary and Maplewood Academy on the Hutchinson campus.

This collection contains annuals from 1952 to 1956.
