

# **Union College Administration Souvenir Plate (Artifact 108)**

## **Artifact**

This round cream-colored plate displays a drawing of the old Administration Building printed in green with gold around the edges of the plate. It measures 10.25" in diameter. The drawing was either created by Dr. Frank L. Marsh or created from a picture he took. Marsh taught biology at Union College from the mid-1930s to about 1950.
