

Kern Court Sign (Artifact 128)

Artifact

Two sections of wrought iron lettering which were formerly attached to the retaining wall in front of the Kern Court apartments at 4928 Bancroft Avenue. Section 1 measures 14" x 59" and reads "M.E. Kern." Section 2 measures 14" x 67" and reads "Court 1948." Kern Court was built in 1948.

When Union College purchased the section of Bancroft (from 49th Street to 51st) and 51st Street (from Bancroft to Calvert) circa January 2012, the address at Kern Court was changed to 3640 S. 49th Street (west half) and 3644 S. 49th Street (east half).

Provenance

This sign was removed when Kern Court was torn down in 2013 to make way for a parking lot and the Krueger Center. Bruce Bottsford of Plant Service delivered the sign to the Heritage Room on July 3, 2013.
