Artifacts

A136 – Khaki colored garrison cap with squared corners. Size 6 7/8 in. and manufactured by Imperial Caps (Denver, Colorado). Lined with yellow satin.

A137 – Khaki colored garrison cap with squared corners. Inside labeld “Dick.” This cap may have been home sewn.

A138 – Khaki colored garrison cap with squared corners. Inside labeld “Don Dick.” Lined with red satin. Don Dick was Everett’s son.
