

Medical Cadet Corps Garrison Caps (Artifacts 139, 140, and 141)

Artifacts

A139 – Teal garrison cap with rounded corners and trimmed in purple. The 1940s “S.D.A. M.C.C.” patch is sewn on it. The manufacturer’s tag has the name “Tom” written on the back side of it.

A140 – Khaki colored garrison cap with squared corners. The 1950s “S.D.A. M.C.C.” patch is sewn on it.

A141 – Olive drab garrison cap with rounded corners and made of wool. The size is marked on the inside band, 6 7/8 inches.
