

Eggshell Model with Old and New Clocktowers (Artifact 74)

Artifact

Three dimensional representation of the old and new Union College clocktowers placed inside of half eggshells. Clocktowers are constructed out of matte board. Eggshells made of papier-mache. Mounted on foam core, 36" by 30".

Provenance

The eggshell model with the old and new clocktowers was crafted by student artist Steve Creitz (1993 grad) in April 1989 to have at a pre-centennial program building up to the centennial in 1991. Students, faculty and staff enjoyed a buffet supper and short program on April 11 when this model was "unveiled." Steve Creitz is also the artist for the new golden cords picture that hangs in the lobby of the Everett Dick Administration Building.
