This small china souvenir plate measures 6" in diameter. It is white with gold edging and a gold circle around the picture of the tour group depicted in the middle. Additional oriental designs in black frame the picture. On the reverse a red stamp reads "Made in Taiwan Rep. of China."

In the photograph members of the 1971 Union college World Tour group stand on the steps of a Taiwanese building and behind a banner reading "Union College World Tour." The photograph is in black and white.

The following individuals have been identified in the picture: Chloe Foutz (front row third from right), Dr. George Thomson, tour leader (second row third from right), Dr. R. K. Nelson, tour leader (second row first from left), Evelyn Thomson (front row fifth from left), Mrs. R. V. (Alta) Axford (second row third from left), and Dr. R. V. Axford (third row second from left). The first person in the third row on the left next to Dr. Axford may be his daughter, Miss M. Axford.
