

Gavel and Block (Artifact 98)

Artifact

Gavel and pounding block made of oak. The gavel is approximately 12 inches long and the block is approximately 5.5 inches in diameter.

Provenance

The gavel and pounding block were made by Dr. Walter Page from wood taken from the original oak stair railing in the 1891-1975 Union College Administration building. An identical set was made at the same time and presented to the Association of Seventh-day Adventist Librarians by Chloe Foutz in 1986, ASDAL's 5th anniversary and Union College's 95th anniversary.
