

# **Immunization Requirements**

## General Requirements

- All students
  - o MMR –2 shots after the first birthday or titers for Mumps, Rubeola, and Rubella proving immunity, or a signed Affidavit
- Residence hall students
  - Meningococcal 1 shot at age 16, booster needed if received before 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, or signed Waiver – must be signed by parent if under age 19
- Internationally born students (above requirements plus):
  - o TB Screening Questionnaire and negative PPD skin test within last year. If positive, lab documentation of negative T-SPOT lab or Quantiferon Gold required. If positive, a physician visit, chest x-ray, and possible medication treatment per physician discretion and negative yearly TB Screening Questionnaire documentation required.

# Additional Program-Specific Requirements

#### EMT

- o Flu shot within last year
- o Hepatitis A series of 2 shots or get first shot now and second shot before Nicaragua trip
- $\circ$  Hepatitis B 3 shots or titer proving immunity
- Negative TB skin test within last year. If positive, lab documentation of negative T-SPOT lab
  test or Quantiferon Gold required. If positive, a physician visit, chest x-ray, and possible
  medication treatment per medical provider discretion.
- o Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) within last 10 years
- Varicella 2 shots or titer proving immunity
- IRR Semester abroad trip EMT requirements plus the following:
  - o Flu shot within last year
  - Hepatitis A series complete
  - Malaria Prophylaxis
  - o Polio series- 4 shots as a child (or series of 3 shots if age 18 or older when immunized per CDC)
  - o Typhoid –1 shot within last 2 years or oral medication within last 5 years

# Nursing

- o Flu shot within last year
- $\circ$  Hepatitis B 3 shots or titer proving immunity
- o Negative two-step Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) the second test must be administered 1-3 weeks after the first test is given. If skin test positive, lab documentation of negative T-SPOT or Quantiferon Gold required. If lab positive, a physician visit, chest x-ray, and possible medication

treatment per physician discretion. Then yearly negative TB Screening Questionnaire documentation.

- o Negative urine drug screen to enter program
- o Physical Exam prior to admission of the program
- o Tdap within last 10 years
- Varicella 2 shots or titer proving immunity

### OTA

- o Flu Shot within the last year
- o Hepatitis B- 3 shots or titer proving immunity
- Negative 2 step Tuberculin Skin Test (TST)The second test must be administered 1-3 weeks after the first test is given. If skin test positive, lab documentation of negative T-Spot or Quantiferon Gold required. If lab positive, a physician visit, chest x-ray, and possible medication treatment per physician discretion. Then yearly negative TB Screening Questionnaire documentation.
- o Negative urine drug screen
- o Tdap within last 10 years.
- o Varicella-2 shots or titer proving immunity

# • Physician Assistant

- o Flu shot required prior to clinical rotations for third year students
- $\circ$  Hepatitis B 3 shots or titer proving immunity
- Negative TST within last year prior to admission. If positive, lab documentation of negative T-SPOT lab test or Quantiferon Gold required. If positive, a physician visit, chest x-ray, and possible medication treatment per medical provider discretion, and yearly negative TB Screening Questionnaire documentation.
- o Negative 2 Step TST required prior to clinical rotations for third year students
- Negative urine drug screen prior to 3<sup>rd</sup> year rotations begin
- o Physical exam prior to admission to program
- $\circ$  Polio 3-4 shots(one which is injected)depending if received as a child or unimmunized adult, or titer proving immunity
- Tdap within last 10 years
- Varicella 2 shots or titer proving immunity

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
